* This test is used for three purposes:
- To examine how each of our classes rank in relation to classes in other schools nationally.

For example, our $8^{\text {th }}$ grade class scored higher on the Reading test than 99 percent of all other $8^{\text {th }}$ grade classes who took the same test.

- To determine individual student strengths and weaknesses.
- To evaluate our curriculum.
* Percentile scores range from 0 to 99 . The $50^{\text {th }}$ percentile is average.
* The Composite score is a compilation of subtest standardized scores.

This year all the grade level composite scores are in the 87th percentile or higher.

* In particular, we are interested in the scores of the $8^{\text {th }}$ grade class.

All of the subject area scores are 99th percentile, with the composite score in the 99th percentile, an indicator of preparedness for high school academics.

Tracking individual classes:
We tracked the composite scores of six different classes over the past three years. Testing analysts caution against drawing too many conclusions from:

- small sample sizes (like ours)
- composition of groups changing each year (in our case adds and drops)

Nonetheless, we felt it helpful to look at the progress of students by class Composite score.

Comments:

* The average school composite score is in the 95th percentile.
* Students take the lowa test for the first time in $3^{\text {rd }}$ grade.
* The $8^{\text {th }}$ grade Composite score was in the $99^{\text {th }}$ percentile, an excellent indicator of preparedness for $9^{\text {th }}$ grade.
* All average percentile scores for subjects are in the $90^{\text {th }}$ percentile or higher.
