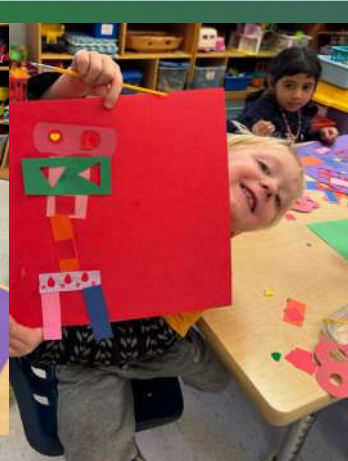
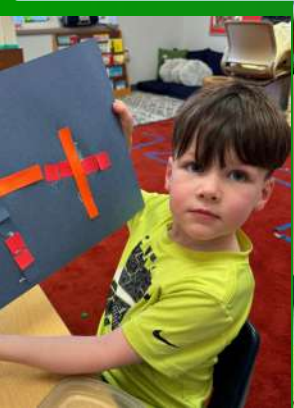


Our 100th day of school was on Tuesday & our Kindergarten Class have 100 items on their shirts! Today they had a "Glow Day" as well.
