School Hours

There is outdoor supervision beginning at 7:45am, doors open at 7:55am, and classes begin at 8:05am. Full day session is 8:05am until 2:55pm; half-day session is 8:05am until 11:55am. The warning bell rings at 8:00am and students are expected to be in their homerooms at 8:05am.

Back to School

Absent and Tardy

If your child(ren) will be absent or tardy, please call the office, 483-0366 ext. #1, by 7:55am. Our answering machine is on 24 hours a day. If your child(ren) arrive after the 8:05am tardy bell, a parent must sign them in at the office. Please note you will need to park your car to sign in your child(ren), and may not idle in the drop off area. *New this year* - After 5 tardies in a quarter, you will be charged \$5/student for any additional late arrival. This money will go directly to the teacher whose class is disrupted. This policy is hopefully not enforced, as we would like everyone on time and ready to learn!

Students must be in attendance for a half day to be eligible for after school activites, practice, or games.

To ensure your child's safety, the office will call your home for any child unaccounted for by a phone call or email.

Illness Policy

The HVCS guideline regarding illness is that children must be free of fever, vomiting, or diarrhea for 24 hours before returning to school.

This guideline follows the recommendation of the Washtenaw County Public Health Dept., the American Academy of Pediatrics, and the U.S. Department of Health and Human Resources.

Lost and Found

Please label your child's gym clothes, uniforms, lunch box, water bottles, and outerwear! The lost and found is located inside the school across from the 1st grade classroom. **All unlabeled and unclaimed items are donated to charity.**

Student Telephone Use

The telephone in the office is primarily for EMERGENCY USE. Students will not be allowed to use the phone to make after school social plans. We will allow students to use the phone if their transportation does not arrive by 3:10pm.

Students should not bring a cell phone to school. If a student must bring a cell phone, the student will be required to sign in their cell phones at the beginning of the day. They will be able to retrieve their cell phone at the end of the school day. This will also include after school activities. A more detailed guideline is included in the handbook.

Lunch Duty

When you arrive for Lunch Duty, please report to the office for instructions. **If you cannot make your lunch duty, please look on the sign-up and call someone else to trade.

Drop-Off and Pick-Up

When you drop-off or pick-up your child(ren), pull up alongside the long sidewalk in front of the school, but please do not stop or park in the crosswalk area at any time. If you are going into the school, park in the lot, and escort your child across the parking lot. Please escort your child(ren) at all times while walking in the parking lot.

After Care

The after care rate is \$6 per child for every half-hour interval. Billing is calculated based on the number of half -hour periods your child remains in after care. For example, if your child stays from 3:15 PM to 3:50 PM, the cost will be \$12. After Care is available dependent on staffing. There is no After Care on half-days.



Pizza Lunches

Pizza will be sold once or twice a month on a Friday.

Pizza is \$1.50 per slice and pop/juice is \$1.00 per item. Profits from the sale benefit the HVCS Athletic Program.

Standing Orders for Pizza and Beverage are submitted at the beginning of the school year. Billing for the pizza and beverage will be sent at the conclusion of each semester. If a student is absent on a Pizza Lunch Day, they will receive a credit for the amount paid.

Pizza will be available to purchase for those without a standing order on the day of the Pizza Lunch, and must be paid at that time.

Service Hours

Parents (grades 1-8) are expected to volunteer for 15 service hours per year. Parents of Kindergarten are expected to volunteer for 10 service hours.

5 hours: Lunch Duty (not for Kindergarten parents)

5 hours: Annual Auction

5 hours: Other

Throughout the year, service hours completed will be recorded in FACTS. Please fill out a yellow slip in the front office or email Karen Hall with completed service hours. **\$15** per hour will be billed in May for any service hours not completed.

Medications at School

An email was sent in August providing some clarification regarding medication authorization forms. Our school medication policy as well as authorization forms were updated this year in compliance with Michigan State Law. The updated policy is included below. A few reminders/highlights:

"Medication" refers to any prescription, nonprescription, homeopathic, herbal, vitamin, or mineral preparation. These can include but are not limited to: cough drops, topical Neosporin or antibiotic ointment, topical creams, etc.

Medications (prescription and over-the-counter) must be accompanied by written, signed instructions from a physician and signed/authorization by a parent /

guardian. These forms must be renewed at the beginning of each school year. If we do not have a medication authorization form signed by both the parent/guardian and a physician/ prescriber, we cannot give any medication at school.

Physician written orders must match the instructions printed on the container's label.

Students may be approved to self-carry and self-administer medications, provided that documentation is submitted with both a physician and parent/guardian signature authorizing the student to do so. Note: there is a section included on the school medication form to authorize self-carry and self-administration of medications.
